

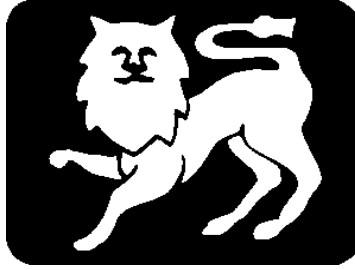

## IMPORTANT NOTES

**EX-CELLAR** There MAY be delays in wines noted as “Ex-cellar” being available for dispatch or collection. Wines that are held by wine storage companies or controlled by legal representatives can take up to two weeks from the date of the auction close to be available for collection and dispatch. Many Sterling Wine Auction vendors use professional wine storage and inventory management systems which involve delays. Only the sold wine travels from the storage location to the Sterling cellar. On occasion wines catalogued are subject to legal control and are released when the sales records are processed for release. Any wine catalogued for Sterling Wine Auction as “Ex-cellar” is guaranteed to be delivered as described in the catalogue.

**GST.** Where the vendor is registered, a Goods & Services Tax (GST) of 10% will be included in the hammerfall of items sold. For all items, GST will be included in the Buyers Premium. Items for which GST applies to the hammerfall will be identified in the catalogue with the symbol \*

The flagship offering, the 2002 Shiraz Old Bastard was fashioned from a vineyard planted in 1896, and was cropped at one ton of fruit per acre. It spent 22 months in French oak before being bottled with neither fining nor filtration. A spectacular perfume of raspberries, plums, blackberries, espresso, vanilla, and charcoal is followed by a tannic Shiraz with a huge palate, massive concentration, tremendous richness, and a multidimensional flavor profile. Less alcoholic (15.2%) than The Bogan, it should be cellared for 4-6 years, and consumed over the following 20-25. While the 2002 is a brilliant effort, it is not quite as massive as the 2001 ... but that's splitting hairs.

Anticipated maturity: 2007-2020+. David Powell, unquestionably one of the world's finest wine producers, has an uncanny ability to discover old vine Barossa vineyards, and then secure long term contracts for their fruit. It is amazing that such high quality sources have not already been plucked by Australia's giant wine corporations. Torbreck's wines continue to get better and better, combining the old vine ripe fruit of Barossa with a European sensitivity to elegance and balance. The finest wines in this portfolio are pricy, but David Powell delivers some remarkable reds and whites at prices that are more than fair for the quality in the bottle

The 2000 Pichon-Longueville Comtesse de Lalande is spectacular, and certainly a noteworthy rival to the 1996, 1995, and even the extraordinary 1982. A blend of 50% Cabernet Sauvignon, 34% Merlot, 10% Petit Verdot, and the rest Cabernet Franc, this effort has a dense saturated purple color, a singular/distinctive yet possibly controversial aromatic smorgasbord existing of creme de cassis, vanilla, and violets, but also tapenade and tree bark. No doubt the Petit Verdot has imparted a certain almost olive-like component to the wine's aromatic profile. In the mouth, it is a wine of extraordinary density, opulence, great presence, and richness. As the 2000 sits in the glass, notes of lavender and melted licorice emerge along with the distinctive tapenade aromas interwoven with creme de cassis, espresso roast, and cedar. The wine is full-bodied, with extraordinary purity and a tremendous texture. I suspect this wine will be relatively approachable young but evolve effortlessly. This is a dramatic, almost flamboyant style that is not classic Pauillac in one sense, but a classic wine. Anticipated maturity: 2007-2025.
